Accident death of Jacques Théoret of Ormstown

Jacques Théoret, well known business man from our area, met with tragic end on Tuesday, January 16, at the age of 53. Mr. Théoret, according to the police report, froze to death after falling in the water of his artificial pond on Rang du Trois in St. Malachie Parish.

It appears, according to first investigation, that Mr. Théoret visited his property on Rang du Trois where he has three ponds. One of which is kept open year round from freezing over by the use of a fountain.

Mr. Théoret usually stops by this open pond to fill a bucket with water to feed the animals in that area. It appears that he fell into the frigid water as he was bending to take some water from the pond.

His absence was noticed; after a search he was found frozen dead in the open ice on the pond. The Ste. Martine Police Force was called at 8:30 a.m. and an agent was dispatched to the site of the discovery.

The body was taken by Ambulance Service I.M. to The Barrie Hospital where a doctor verified Mr. Théoret's decease.

Funeral services were from the Eglise Ste. Barbe on Saturday, January 20. Jacques Théoret was the owner of the Vieux Moulin Hotel in Ormstown, President of Théoret Construction Co. and owner of Hotel La Villa in Ste. Barbe.
