## Valleyfield service held for the late Edith Nearney

At 2 p.m. Saturday, April 22, the funeral service for the late Edith Nearney, (née Rostrum), was held at St. Mark's Anglican Church in Valleyfield, with Fr. E. Majka officiating, and many old family friends from this area attending.

Edith died at her home in Brockville, Ont., on February 10, 1995, at the age of 87.

She was laid to rest beside her beloved husband, Lawrence, and their only daughter, Maureen, in the Valleyfield Protestant Cemetery.

For many years Edith and Lawrence were well known members of the Valleyfield community until their retirement
