summer of 33, and arrived in August. Robt

occupied by Robert. Stayed there 3 years and
then took place ours in. On night of 3rd Nov.
38 there was a knock at door and in husband
opened it found a crowd of Canadians armed with
knives, forks, &c and a few with guns and swords.
Knowing them all he was not alarmed, and they
said they wanted the arms in the house
and not hurt him. They took all, including
two guns belong to my sons who had just
that evening returned from shooting, and who were
standing by their bedside. They took them
without awaking these boys. Nothing but
arms was touched One Canadian opened
