## *R. Bellavance mourned by many in Valley area*

The Valleyfield community, along with many friends, was greatly saddened by the death of Raymond Bellavance on October 8, 1994, at the age of 63.

## Death verdict

A full-scale police investigation into the death of an Ormstown man found under suspicious circumstances last Wednesday, Nov. 9 culminated in a verdict of "death by natural causes".

Following an autopsy conducted at the Montreal Medical-Legal Institute, it was determined that Marcel Cr te of Church St. died from internal hemorrhaging.
